K3QNT moved that the club donate \$25.00 to *Hospice and Community Care of Lancaster, PA* in memory of Lisa. The motion was seconded by KA3PNL.

New Business:

K3SCM suggested we continue our new member incentive program by providing an inexpensive Baofeng HT to each new member so they can get on the repeaters right away. **KA3UDR** said he would look into extending the purchase of the radios.

K3QNT announced he had examined **16** possible Field Day locations for the event in June. After some discussion the members present agreed that the Snake Spring Park would be best because of its location, access to bathrooms, cover and available power. Lloyd will check out availability for the weekend of June 22-23, 2019.

KE3ZT, Activities Director announced the upcoming Bloody Run Canoe Classic to be held on Saturday, 27 April. This event takes place in Everett. BCARS provides operators along the river to observe canoes for safety. The ARES operators muster at Bedford Burger King at 0900 on the day of the event.

Steve outlined the recent DX activity of the 70th Anniversary of Spanish Radio Union. There is an attractive certificate available. The Special Event is on the air from 160 meters to 6 meters.

K3QNT asked everyone to celebrate the 85th Birthday of **Jay Williams**, **K3SCM**, BCARS pioneer and oldest continuously operational Ham in Bedford County! Jay explained that his longevity was due to good living, marital bliss with Linda and close proximity to large amounts of RF.
